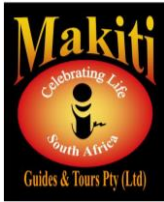

**The qualification is rolled out as a Basic and
Advanced Course offered online in order to qualify
as a Provincial / National Guide.**

Scope: All 9 provinces of South Africa are available.

Course Description: Cover the Provincial, Cultural, Historical and Natural Overviews for each province, as well as all the cities and towns according to the geographical, municipal or tourism regions. It also includes information about the origin of the cities/towns, the origin and meaning of names, claims to fame, economical activities, sites, attractions and things to do.

Course entry requirements:

- 🎓 Registered Provincial Culture Guide or student enrolled for the FETC: Tourist Guiding (71549)
- 🎓 Computer literate
- 🎓 Some practical knowledge of the province

Course delivery: Electronic Courseware - Online www.culturalguiding.com. Visual material (virtual tours) will be provided to assist with sufficient practical knowledge.

Duration: You have two months / province to complete the online theory and assignments. In the event that you are unable to complete it within the given time frame, a request to extend the period should be submitted in writing.

Assessment:

- 🎓 Online tests (formative assessment)
- 🎓 Provincial Overview Assignment
- 🎓 Online final Multiple Choice exam (complete province)

Certification:

- 🎓 Declaration of Competence (DOC) Letter for Registration
- 🎓 Certificate for completing online course

PROCEDURES

Accessing and completing online courses (theory)

1. Login and click on 'My Courses'
2. Click on 'Normal view'
3. Click on the Province you have selected.
4. Click on the first component.
5. After reading through the material, click on 'Take test' (top right corner).

6. Complete all the components in the same manner.
7. You will receive an electronic Certificate for completing the course online.

Assignments and final Assessment (summative)

8. After completion of the theory online request template for the Provincial overview. Submit for evaluation upon completion.
9. Make an appointment with the Assessor to take the online Multiple Choice Exam.
10. A link for the Online Multiple Choice Exam will be forwarded on request should you wish to take it at a site other than MGT offices (Pretoria). In this event, you should organise a Supervisor (to be approved by the Assessor).
11. Should you not meet the requirements of 80% for the Exam, the Assessor will do oral questioning (Skype interview will be arranged for students who cannot come to the office). The Assessor will indicate if you should first do more studying before the oral questioning.

Declaration of Competence (DOC)

- Upon successful completion of all of the above, the following will be forwarded to you electronically: **Declaration of Competence letter** to be presented to the Provincial Tourism Authority where you registered for the first time.
- The additional province/s will be added to your scope (you will receive an updated registration card). Should you register all nine provinces a *National Tourist Guide badge* will be issued as well.
